Activity 3

Read A Rosh Hashanah Walk by Carol Levin

Art: Crumb Pouch

(2) 6x9 Foam Sticky Back Glitters Sheets

Different foam stickers

Plastic Ziplock Bags

Cracker

Prep 6x9 Foam sheets by cutting a one inch strip inside three sides of each sheet

Give each child two sheets and have them peel the three strips inside each sheet and then stick together

Have the children decorate each pouch with stickers

Then let each child put three cracker inside a plastic baggie, (Zip it up after removing the air)

Let each child repeat their sorry statement and then smash the crumbs.

The plastic baggie and crumbs can be put into the decorated pouch and then emptied during A Tashlich Walk on Rosh Hashanah Afternoon
